

Did you know you can contribute up to \$400 to help burn survivors... *and it won't cost you a dime?*

Here's how it works...

The Foundation for Burns and Trauma, Inc. is a qualifying charity for the Arizona State Tax Credit for Contributions to Charities that Assist the Working Poor (A.R.S. 43-1088). The name may be complicated but the program is very simple. If you make a donation (OF ANY AMOUNT) to a qualified charity and itemize deductions on your Arizona tax return, you are eligible to take the credit. The credit is not a deduction but a dollar for dollar match of your donation. You will receive up to \$200 if you are single and up to \$400 if you are married and file jointly. If you considered the tax credit in the past but were frustrated by the confusing "baseline amount" requirement, there is great news; **THE BASELINE YEAR REQUIREMENT NO LONGER EXISTS. You ARE eligible for the credit if you itemize your taxes in Arizona!**

The Foundation for Burns and Trauma operates the Arizona Children's Burn Camp, the Forever Courage House, and conducts emotional and financial relief programs for those impacted by severe burn injuries. They are a major partner in smoke alarm outreach efforts throughout the state and have contributed nearly 2,000 smoke alarms to Arizona fire departments.
